Gallatin County Extension Homemakers are a part of the Kentucky Extension Homemakers Association (KEHA), founded in 1932 in cooperation with the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service.

Scholarship Application Requirements:

1. Limited to Gallatin County High School seniors in good standing to graduate.
2. Must continue their education after high school (Vocational-Technical program or a College).
3. To be considered you must provide answers to all sections. If extra space is needed to list your answers you may use additional paper. High school transcripts with grade point average, grade rank is optional but can be included.
4. Return application to the Guidance Counselor's office no later than **May 1**.
