Inaredients:

- 2 cups flour
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- 1 1/4 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 egg
- 1/2 cup canned pumpkin
- 1 3/4 cup milk, low-fat
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil

Directions:

- In a large mixing bowl, combine flour, brown sugar, baking powder, pumpkin pie spice and salt.
- In a medium bowl, combine egg, canned pumpkin, milk, and vegetable oil, mixing well.
- Add wet ingredients to flour mixture, stirring just until moist. Batter may be lumpy. For thinner batter, add more milk.
- Lightly coat a griddle or skillet with cooking spray and heat to medium.
- Drop batter mixture onto the prepared griddle by heaping tablespoon. Cook until golden brown, turning once with a spatula when the surface begins to bubble. Continue cooking until the other side is golden brown. Repeat process, making 12 pancakes.





2025 Annual Piggy Bank Design Contest

It is time for the annual Piggy Bank Design Contest. Your job is to build a piggy bank any shape or design.

You must bring it to school by

Monday, November 18. 2024.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Entries must meet the following requirements to be eligible for judging:

The bank cannot exceed12 inches X 12 inches X 12 inches (1 square foot).

Piggy banks must be able to hold coins (i.e., include a slot that has been cut to insert coins).

Piggy banks must be created or decorated by the youth contestant.

Piggy banks DO NOT have to be in the shape of a pig.

You MAY use or repurpose other containers.

Piggy banks will be judged at the school as People's Choice. The winning bank from the school will sent to the Gallatin County Extension Office to be judged. The Grand Champion Bank will then compete against area counties. Piggy Banks must be submitted and judged through the Gallatin County Cooperative Extension Office.

Prizes—There will be a first, second and third prize for each grade level sponsored by the Gallatin County 4-H Council. Prizes include games, pencils, and another surprise. The Grand Prize of \$50 is sponsored by German American Bank.

Each bank must include Child's first and last name, grade level, and teacher.


