Recipe of the Month Italian One Pot Pasta & Beans

Ingredients:

- 1 Tbsp. oil
- 1 medium yellow or white onion, diced
- 1 large carrot, diced
- 1 stalk celery, diced
- 2 minced garlic cloves, or 2 Tbsp. garlic powder
- 1 Tbsp. Italian seasoning
- 1 cups low-sodium vegetable broth or water
- 1 can (15 oz.) no-salt added diced tomatoes
- 1 can (15 oz.) no-salt added tomato sauce
- 1 1/2 cups dry elbow macaroni or ditalini pasta 2 cans (15 oz.) white beans, such as cannellini, undrained
- 1 tsp. salt

Parmesan cheese (optional)

Directions:

- Wash hands with warm water and soap, scrubbing for at least 20 seconds.
- Rinse produce under cool running water and scrub clean with vegetable brush.
- Over medium heat, add oil to a large pot. Sauté onion, carrots and celery until soft.
- 4. Add garlic and Italian seasoning and stir for one minute.
- Add broth, diced tomatoes and tomato sauce and bring mixture to a boil
- Stir in uncooked pasta. Simmer, stirring from time to time for 7 to 9 minutes until pasta is almost cooked.
- 7. Stir in beans and salt. Simmer another 5 minutes.
- Ladle into bowls and top with parmesan cheese, if desired.
- 9. Store leftovers in the refrigerator within 2 hours.
